I. General Information

- A. Upholds and defends the ASGSCU Constitution and Bylaws.
- B. Advocates student's rights and provide services and programs to further that goal.
- C. Supervised by the Chief Justice.

II. Essential Responsibility

- A. Responsible for attending all Judicial Branch meetings and functions, including those of the Student Court.
- B. Responsible for working to further the goals and programs established by ASGSCU and the Judicial Branch.

III. Specific Responsibilities

- A. Assist in the interpretation of the Constitution, Bylaws and other legislation of ASGSCU.
- B. Uphold the integrity of ASGSCU by holding accountable all officers in regards to their explicit duties and responsibilities as outlined in the Constitution and Bylaws.
- C. Maintain confidential all details regarding any case(s) accepted by the Student Court; to weigh evidence carefully and to rationally cast your vote in accordance with the integrity and values of the Judicial Branch, as determined by the Constitution, Bylaws, and Chief Justice.
- D. Perform individual project work and external research as delegated by the Chief Justice.
- E. Assist in the coordination and planning of Judicial Branch programs and services.

IV. Qualifications

- A. Must be currently enrolled in at least one course as an undergraduate student at SCU.
- B. Must be in good academic and behavioral standing with the University (e.g., minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA and not on any type of probation as defined in the Undergraduate Bulletin, etc.).
- C. Must maintain fairness and objectivity in all official hearings and disciplinary procedures.

V. Appointment

- A. Appointed to a one year term of office by the Chief Justice in consultation with Student Body President and Student Body Vice President and confirmed by the Student Senate.
- B. Transition begins mid-Spring Quarter with outgoing Associate Justices.

VI. Time Requirements

- A. Meet 1 hour bi-monthly with the Chief Justice
- B. Meet 1 hour weekly with the Judicial Branch.
- C. Attend 1 Student Senate meeting per month.
- D. Participate in all Student Court proceedings.
- E. Attend quarterly ASGSCU retreat.
- F. Participate in all transition activities enumerated in the ASGSCU Bylaws.
- G. Estimated time per week: 5 hours.
